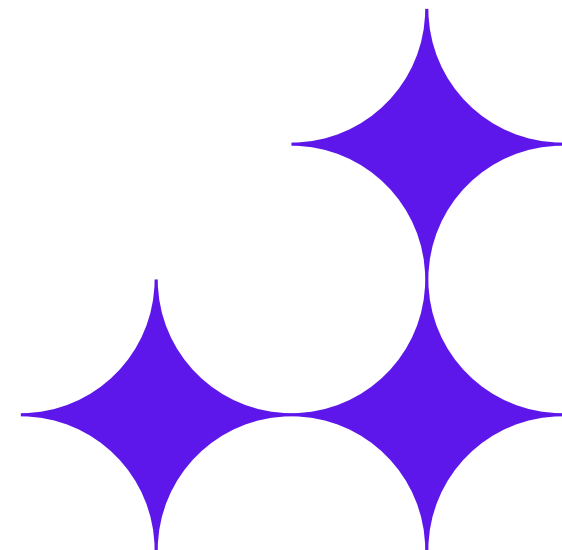
FIRST! Join our Band!

How We Teach

Our lessons are for everyone – all ages, all experience levels, and all goals. We don't teach traditional sheet music; instead, we focus on the skills that make music fun and practical in the real world. You'll learn through the Nashville Number System, rhythm, pitch, dynamics, ear training, and stage presence, along with songwriting and modern performance methods. Whether you want to play in a band, sing for fun, or perform on stage, we meet you right where you are and help you grow from there.

Why We Don't Teach Sheet Music

Classical training through sheet music is a wonderful way to learn and has created generations of incredible musicians. But it's designed for a different style – one focused on orchestras, choirs, and traditional performance settings. At George Guitars, our students are aiming for something else: the ability to play by ear, perform on stage, write songs, and jam with other musicians in real time. That's why we use tools like the Nashville Number System, ear training, and modern performance methods. Both approaches are valuable – it just depends on the kind of musician you want to be.

- We don't use traditional lesson books, so there's no need to buy materials to get started.
- As you continue, we'll guide you on what (if anything) you'll want to bring each week.

Policies and Procedures

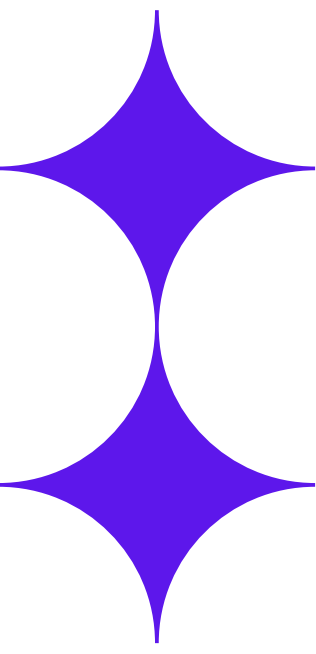
To keep scheduling simple and lessons consistent, we've created clear studio policies that apply to all students and families.

Important Things to Know

- Lessons are weekly, one-on-one 30-minute classes
- Tuition is billed monthly, not per lesson
- Lesson Rates:
 - \$125 per month for one class
 - \$100 per month per class for families enrolled in multiple classes
- Some months include five lesson weeks, and all five weeks are included
- The studio observes scheduled breaks throughout the year so families don't need to reschedule around holidays
- If a lesson is missed:
 - With notice, a take-home lesson may be provided
 - No-shows do not receive a makeup or credit
- All scheduling updates, lesson materials, and announcements are shared through the Band App

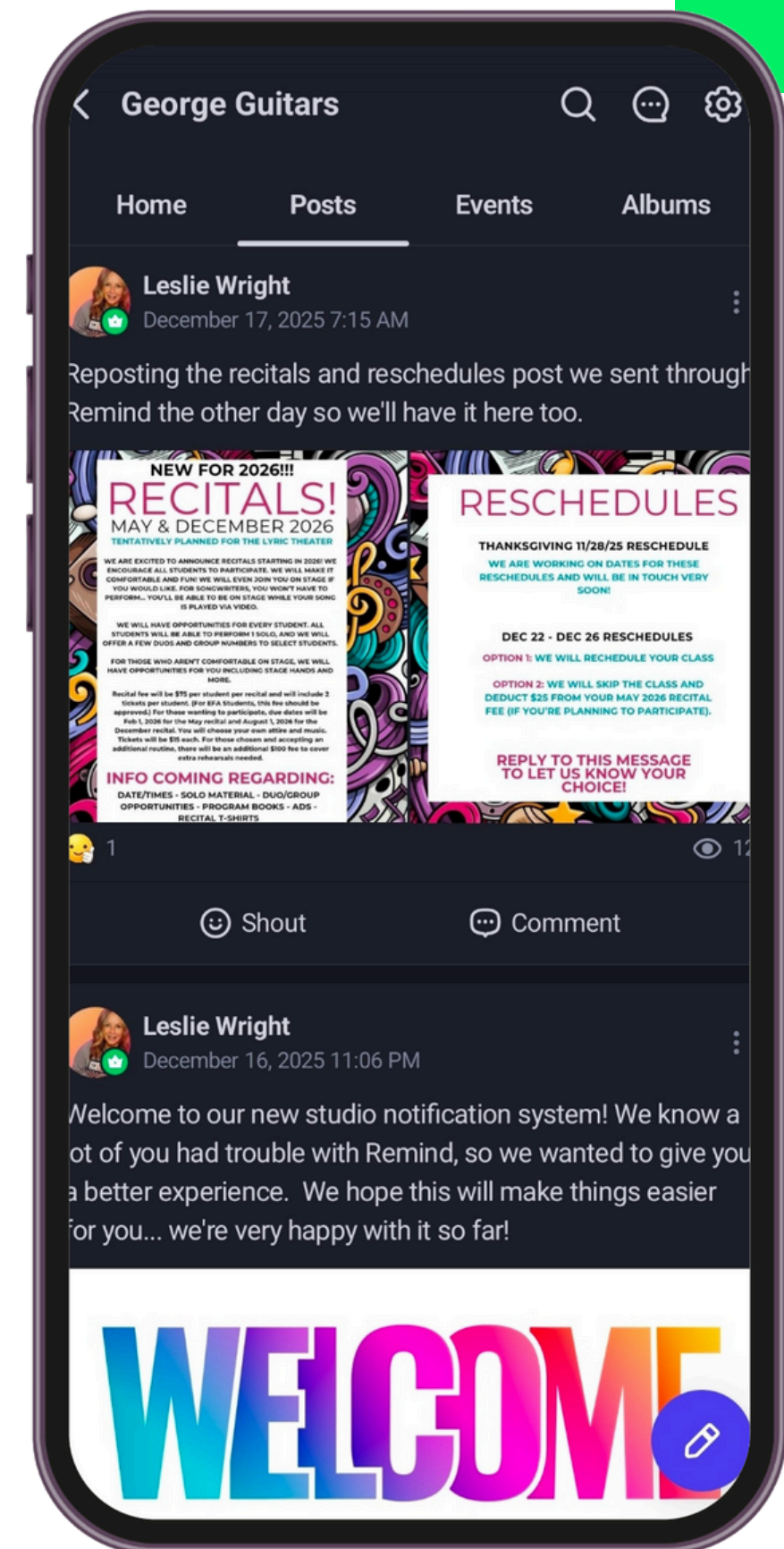

Our goal is simple: make recitals comfortable, encouraging, and FUN. This is not a rigid or intimidating performance environment – it's a celebration of progress.

What Makes Our Recitals Different

- We want every student to feel welcome and supported, regardless of experience level.
- All levels encouraged to participate

- Students will typically perform one solo, and we will also offer a limited number of duos and group numbers for select students.

Not Comfortable Performing Solo? That's OK!

We believe participation looks different for every student.

- Songwriters may choose to be on stage while their song plays via video
- Instructors can join students on stage if needed
- For students who aren't ready to perform, we'll offer alternative participation options, such as stage support roles

No one is forced into something they're not ready for!

Recital Fees & Tickets

Recital Fee: Nonrefundable \$75 per student per recital (Summer & Christmas)

- Only one fee per student regardless of number of classes you take or number of shows you're in per recital
- Includes 2 tickets
- (EFA students: recital fee should be approved)

Additional tickets: \$15 each

Additional routine fee: \$100

(applies only to students selected for and accepting an extra duo/group routine to cover additional rehearsals)





Info for our EFA Students



George Guitars is an approved Direct Pay vendor for the Arkansas EFA Learns program. This means your tuition can be paid directly through your EFA account, making lessons simple and affordable for your family.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR EFA STUDENTS!

Is George Guitars an approved vendor? What exactly does that mean?

Yes! We've been an approved vendor since 2023. This means you will be able to "direct pay" us right from your EFA portal rather than pay up-front and wait for reimbursement.

Do I still have to register on the George Guitars site?

Yes! Once you're approved for EFA funding, we will need you to use our registration form to sign up for music classes. This form has nothing to do with EFA – it's simply for our own record keeping and invoicing system.

How does billing work?

For EFA students, you will receive your invoice on the 15th of the month prior to when it's due. For example, you'll receive your September bill on August 15. We do this because it takes a little longer for us to receive our funding from your account. You will then access your EFA portal and "direct pay" us through your student's account. Each child will have their own invoice each month.

How many music classes can my child take?

Music classes are considered core curriculum, so there are no limits!

Are the online courses included or only in person classes?

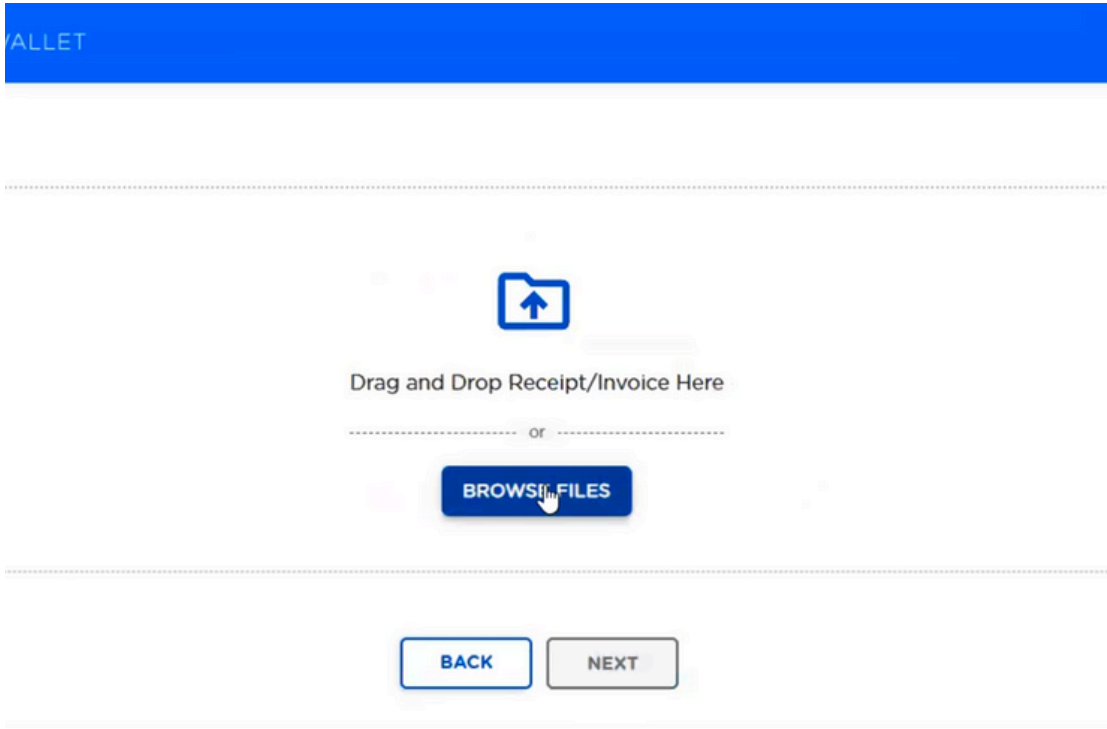
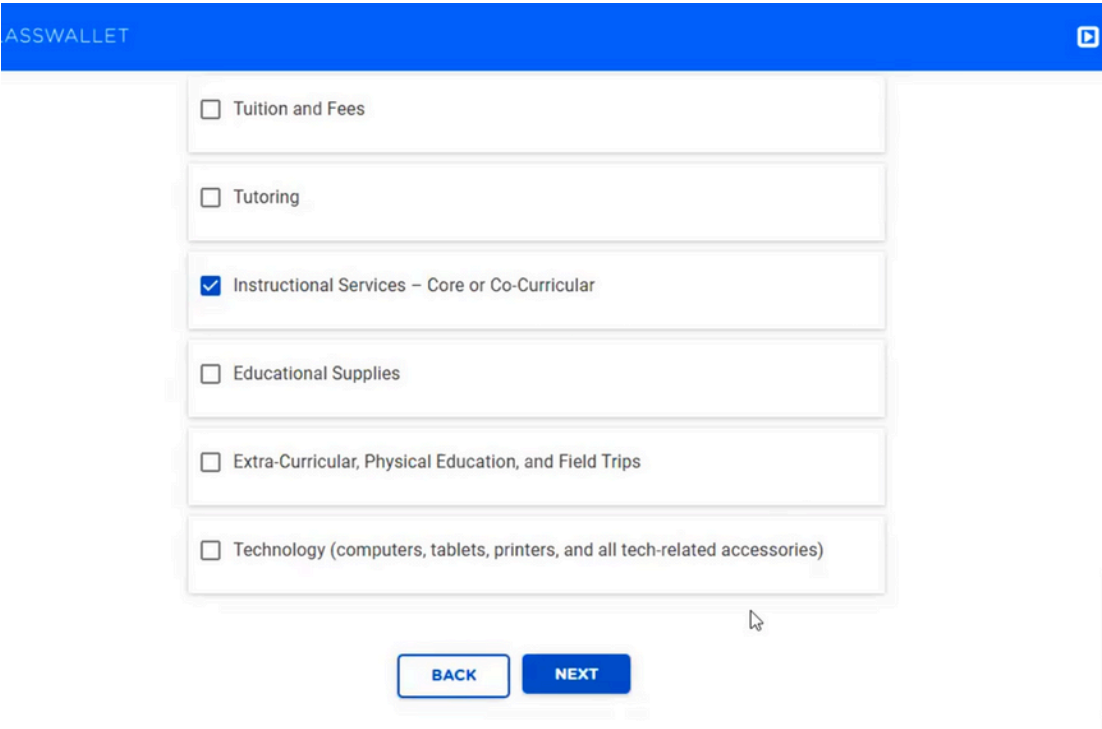
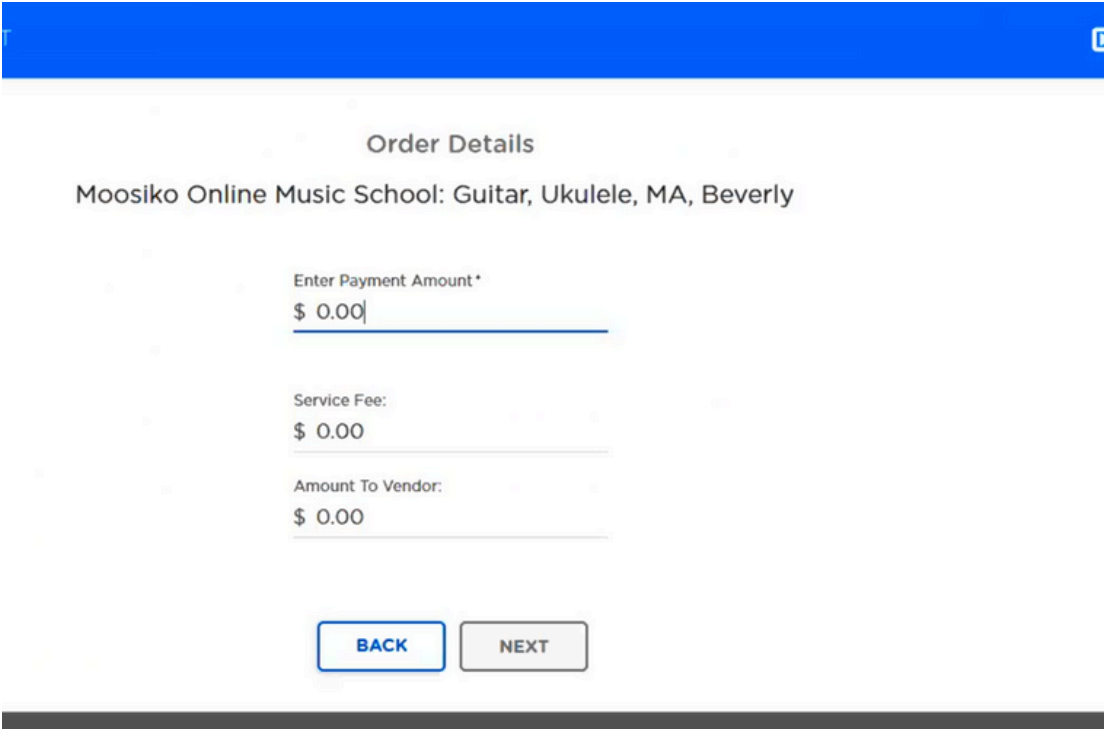
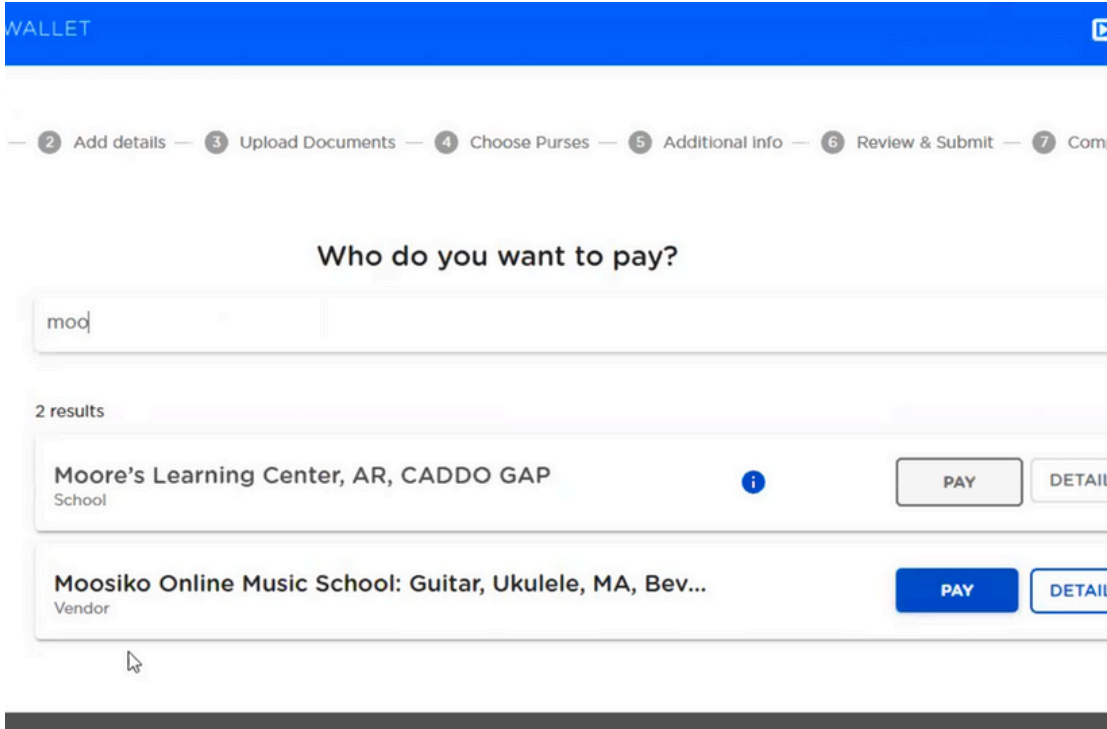
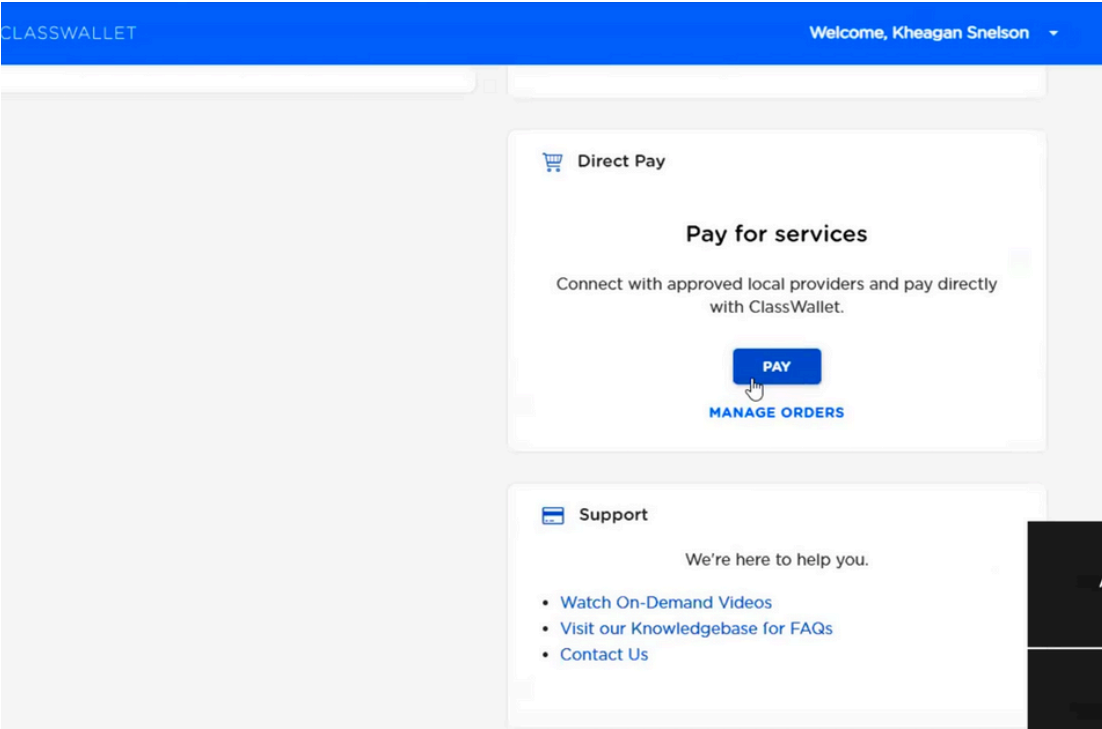
Yes! All of our courses – both in person and online – are approved.

Are instruments allowable expenses with EFA funds?

As of 2025, they now allow "reasonably priced instruments" to be funded. We offer bundles that have been pre-approved by EFA to make things easy for you.

EFA Direct Pay Help

When you receive your invoice from George Guitars on the 22nd of each month, log into Class Wallet, choose Direct Pay, choose George Guitars, enter the amount, and then upload the invoice. That's it!



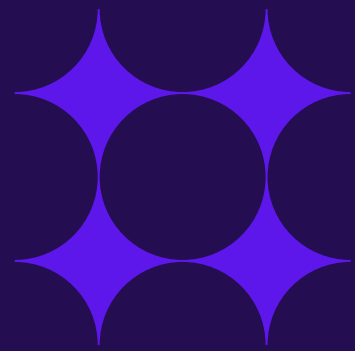
